After initially becoming involved in the self-help groups as a survivor of violence, Evelyn has trained as a Legal Advisor and now accompanies and supports other survivors of violence through her work with the project and in her community. She is very well-known within the Honduran feminist movement circles, as well as by officials in the judicial system.



Mercedes Lainez is a respected community leader who first became involved in the self-help groups as a survivor of violence in 2006. She has subsequently become a facilitator of women's self-help groups and is an active member of the Feminists in Resistance movement, with whom she has participated in demonstrations against the military coup and in political advocacy events in defense of women's rights.
